

## Becoming an On Air Programmer

1. Attend an orientation session. Contact the Volunteer Coordinator for upcoming dates and times. CFUV also offers women-only orientation and training workshops upon request.
2. All volunteer must complete six hours of volunteer service.
3. Following your volunteer hours you will sign up and attend a training workshop in Studio One.
4. To qualify or training with CFUV you must join the Radio Club. Membership dues are \$15 for UVic Students and \$25 for all other community members.
5. Become familiar with CFUV and CRTC policies and read the orientation manual. (Available on the website: cfuv.uvic.ca)
6. Book a written review with the Program Director to analyze your technical skills and knowledge of campus community radio.
7. Upon passing the written review, you must prepare a 25 minute demo tape and submit it with a program proposal to the Program Director for approval.
8. Upon approval you can then sign up for on air training with the Program Director.
9. If you are interested in public affairs, conducting interviews or podcasting you can sign up for newsroom training!
10. Once you have completed your on air training you will then become eligible to broadcast live.



### On Air Programmers Can...

- Host a program or contribute to an existing program
- Act as a replacement host
- Sign up to apprentice a live performance and learn technical training in Studio One.
